MATERIAL

Colossians, I & II Timothy (*New King James Version*)

- Novice (1st & 2nd year quizzers): Colossians and I Timothy 1-5
- Senior: Colossians, I Timothy and II Timothy 1:1-4:5
- Three-ring notebook with plastic page protectors

To stay on track it is recommended students memorize 7-11 verses per week and then review by quoting ALL of the learned material once or twice a week.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT

We ask every parent to be involved in the leadership of Bible Quiz to some degree. For some parents that is every week as a coach or listener, for others it maybe leading a devotional, helping with a fundraiser or hosting at an invitational. Please plan to be involved this year ahead. We appreciate your investment as we help students memorize and apply God's Word!

At Home:

Weekly pray for and encourage your student.
Weekly listen to your student quote their material.
Weekly sign-off the student's pace sheet.

For Invitationals (local competitions):

When HCC is hosting: provide housing for students of other churches, provide Friday night snacks and help with lunch meal.

COSTS

Invitationals: \$5 for food and gas

Regionals: estimated \$90 for food, lodging and gas

Nationals: usually estimated \$800-1000 for youth conference, flight, activities, etc. (pending sending a team—more info will be communicated in January-February)

Uniform: under \$40 (coaches will take students shopping as a group in the spring to select the uniform for Regionals & Nationals)

QUIZZING

A team is made up of up to six quizzers. Four quiz at one time with two substitutes. Two teams compete at one time.

A quiz has 20 questions. The first quizzer to buzz in has the opportunity to finish the question and answer the question (all within 30 seconds). If the quizzer answers incorrectly, the question is referred to the opposing team.

Points:

- A correct buzz +20
- An incorrect buzz -10
- Referral +10

Team Bonuses:

- A quizzer “quizzed out” with 5 correct and no incorrect buzzes +10
- 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th team member with a correct buzz +10 each

TIPS FOR QUOTING TO PREPARE FOR QUIZZING

- Quote out loud!
- Read through all of the material several times before memorizing.
- Say the verse numbers to reinforce what verse it is.
- Get as few helps as possible, especially for the first word of the verse.
- Have a quoting partner for accountability.
