



Dear T&T Parents,

We are so excited to be working with your T&T clubbers again this year! T&T stands for Truth & Training and is a program for kids in third through sixth grade. It focuses on deepening kids' understanding of biblical truth, as well as giving them stronger life application practices to live out their faith so that they can grow as disciples of Jesus Christ.

Every Awana Club night is made up of three 30 minute sessions:

- **Game Time** in the Family Life Center gym, where the T&T boys and girls play active games, learn sportsmanship, and compete to win team points.
- **Large Group Time** - a time of teaching where clubbers will explore some of the fundamental doctrines of Christianity. Clubbers will spend time learning about the character and nature of God, the structure and sequence of the Bible, the redemption narrative, and key discipleship practices.
- **Small Group Time** - where Clubbers break into smaller groups to work through their handbooks and continue to explore the topic presented during Large Group Time through discussion, study and memorization of relevant Bible verses.

This year all T&T grade levels will be in the same *Mission – Evidence of Grace(EOG)* handbook and follow the “Together We Move” format. All grades will progress through the handbook sections together following a pre-determined schedule to finish the sections required to earn a book award by the end of the year.

What can you do?

- Support your child in working through his or her lesson activities in the handbook. Keep in mind that there are things labeled optional and extra credit that don't need to be done if he or she doesn't have time.
- Have a Bible available for your child in the English Standard Version (ESV) translation.
- Encourage your child in memorizing the lesson's memory verses by practicing with them.
- Connect with your child over what he or she is learning. Each week via email we will provide you with parent resource pages that can help with this. These include lesson summaries and great conversation starters to help engage your child with what he or she is learning.
