- Things that are easily broken, expensive or hard to replace or any items for “practical jokes.”
- Drugs, alcohol, weapons or fireworks. These items undermine the purpose of retreat. They will not be allowed. Your cooperation in working with your student to ensure this is adhered to is appreciated.

## **CELL PHONES**

We discourage sending a cell phone to camp/retreat with your student. An important purpose of our time away is for people to connect face-to-face and be removed from distractions of social media. Students may always be contacted at retreat through the staff contact numbers provided. If a student brings a cell phone we will ask him/her to put it away. Please note that we are not responsible for misplaced, lost or stolen items.
