Attention Parents: God chose to use the family as the primary place to nurture faith. Our staff and KidsQuest teachers are delighted to come alongside you and your child on this journey of knowing God and walking in His paths. Please notice that we've included the verses that will be taught and the main Bible truth that will be conveyed, so that during the week leading up to Sunday, you can preview the passage with your child as you help them memorize their verse.

- January 7** **Bible Truth:** Workers use their special skills to honor God and to serve others. Exodus 35:30-36:7
Memory Verse: So whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all for the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31
- January 14** **Bible Truth:** As a farmer cares for young plants, God patiently watches over His children. I Kings 19:19-21; Mark 4:3-20
Memory Verse: "And other seeds fell into good soil and produced grain, growing up and increasing and yielding thirtyfold and sixtyfold and a hundredfold." Mark 4:8
- January 21** **Bible Truth:** As a potter shapes soft clay, God molds His children to be righteous like Him. Jeremiah 18
Memory Verse: But now, O LORD, you are our Father; we are the clay, and you are our potter; we are all the work of your hand. Isaiah 64:8
- January 28** **Bible Truth:** As a builder constructs a grand building, God builds strong character into His children. Genesis 6
Memory Verse: For we are God's fellow workers. You are God's field, God's building. 1 Corinthians 3:9
- February 4** **Bible Truth:** As servants honor their kind master, God's children eagerly serve and please Him. Genesis 37; 39:1-6
Memory Verse: "The greatest among you shall be your servant." Matthew 23:11
- February 11** **Bible Truth:** As a weaver fashions fine cloth, God weaves His children into special creations. Proverbs 31:10-31
Memory Verse: Review the five verses above and recite two of them to your KidsQuest teacher.

- February 18** **Bible Truth:** As a shepherd leads his beloved sheep, Jesus guides His children to follow Him. Psalm 23
Memory Verse: *The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.*
Psalm 23:1
- February 25** **Bible Truth:** As a musician savors beautiful song, God delights in adoration and praise. I Chronicles 15:14-29
Memory Verse: *It is good to give thanks to the LORD, to sing praises to Your name, O Most High.* Psalm 92:1
- March 4** **Bible Truth:** As a vineyard worker harvests sweet grapes, God produces spiritual fruit in His children. I Kings 21
Memory Verse: *"I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in Me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing."* John 15:5
- March 11** **Bible Truth:** As a soldier battles a dangerous enemy, God's children combat Satan's evil forces. I Samuel 17:4-50
Memory Verse: *Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.* Ephesians 6:11
- March 18** **Bible Truth:** As a merchant runs an honest business, God treats His children with wisdom and fairness. I Kings 9:26-10:29
Memory Verse: *The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom, and his tongue speaks justice.* Psalm 37:30
- March 25** **Bible Truth:** As a metalworker forges valuable metal, God purifies His precious children. I Kings 7:13-51
Memory Verses: Review the five verses above and recite two of them to your KidsQuest teacher.
