PURPOSE

Summer camp is all about helping students experience spiritual encouragement and growth. We are going to make incredible memories, build spiritual friendships, and discover the life God has for us.

COST & REGISTRATION

\$315 with a \$100 non-refundable, non-transferrable deposit due at the time of your online registration. Balance is billed per a confirmation email with final billing details included. Space is limited. Register for High School Summer Camp by June 1 at highlandsc.org/student-events.

LOCATION

We exclusively rent out Drift Creek Camp near Lincoln City, Oregon for our week of camp.

TRAVEL PLANS

Please arrive promptly at 8:30 am on Sunday, July 29 in the lower parking lot at the Renton campus to load your gear and check in. We will depart shortly thereafter. We will arrive back in the HCC lower parking lot at approximately 6:30 pm on Saturday, August 4. Parents may call our information line at 206-957-2345 for a recorded message with the latest updates on our return time on Saturday after 3:30 pm.

BAPTISMS AT CAMP

Every year we offer the students the opportunity to follow Jesus in obedience through baptism. If your student desires to be baptized at High School Summer Camp, please talk about this in advance and let us know. If your student plans to be baptized at camp, please complete the online registration at <http://highlandsc.org/baptism/>. If your student decides during camp to be baptized, we will make every effort to contact you. Pictures and video will be taken of each student's baptism. Parents are welcome to join us at camp for the baptism on Thursday, August 2, at 1:00 pm. Please let us know in advance if you plan on attending. WHAT TO BRING

- Sunscreen
- Bible, pen and notebook
- Sleeping bag and pillow (in plastic garbage sack & labeled)
- Modest swimsuit
- Personal items & towels
- Spending money for the Snack Shack*
- Flashlight
- Water bottle
- Cool clothes for daytime
- Warm clothes for evenings (temps mid 60s-low 70s)
- Lunch or money for the trip to camp
- Lunch money for the return trip

* Purchase a pre-paid punch card online in advance via our online registration system. We will also accept cash or card, but pre-paid card is best.

Please label everything with his/her name, even the pillow, sleeping bag (in a plastic garbage sack) and dufflee bag or suitcase. Once we get to camp, everyone's things look the same!

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Things that are easily broken, expensive or hard to replace

Drugs, alcohol, weapons, knives, matches, fireworks or items for practical pranks

MAIL AT CAMP

Families have the option to drop off mail at check in on Sunday. We will then distribute it at camp during the week to your camper. Please do not send mail directly to camp. It is a remote location and mail is only picked up once a week.

MEDICATIONS

Please check-in prescriptions, special meds and over the counter meds at the table marked "Medical Staff" when you arrive at the FLC. For safety, students will not carry their own medications so please be sure not to pack them!

WHAT TO EXPECT

There are a lot of different things offered during the week of camp. The following are a few of the highlights we have planned: gatherings with quality music and teaching, small group discussions, wakeboarding, intertubing, beach volleyball, shopping at Lincoln City Outlets, surfing (sign up in advance), field games, community center rental with pool, water slides, hot tub, rock climbing, basketball and open gym.

CELL PHONES

We discourage sending a cell phone to camp with your student. An important purpose of our time away is for people to connect face-to-face and be removed from distractions of social media. Students may always be contacted at camp through the staff contact numbers provided. There is no cell reception at camp. Please note that we are not responsible for misplaced, lost or stolen items.
