Attention Parents: God chose to use the family as the primary place to nurture faith. Our staff and KidsQuest teachers are delighted to come alongside you and your child on this journey of knowing God and walking in His paths. Please notice that we've included the verses that will be taught and the main Bible truth that will be conveyed, so that during the week leading up to Sunday, you can preview the passage with your child as you help them memorize their verse.

- April 1
Easter** **Bible Truth:** Jesus dies and comes back to life to pay for the sins of all people
- Memory Verse:** *Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6*
- April 8** **Bible Truth:** Jesus encourages His followers to use money in ways that please God. Luke 1
- Memory Verse:** *No servant can serve two masters, for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money. Luke 16:13*
- April 15** **Bible Truth:** Jesus demonstrates how faith in Him touches every area of life. Luke 17:7-18:4
- Memory Verse:** *Whoever seeks to preserve his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life will keep it. Luke 17:33*
- April 22** **Bible Truth:** Jesus show that faithfulness to God and to family matters most. Matthew 19
- Memory Verse:** *But Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." Matthew 19:26*
- April 29** **Bible Truth:** Jesus measures greatness by a person's willingness to trust Him and to serve others. Matthew 20:1-28
- Memory Verse:** *Review the last four verses and say two of them to your KidsQuest teacher.*
- May 6** **Bible Truth:** Jesus counsels His followers to invest their lives for God's Kingdom. Luke 18:31-19:27
- Memory Verse:** *And He said to him, "Well done, good servant! Because you have been faithful in a very little, you shall have authority over ten cities." Luke 19:17*

May 13
Mother's Day

Bible Truth: Jesus displays His authority to judge. Matthew 21

Memory Verse: *Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!* Matthew 21:9

May 20

Bible Truth: Jesus warns his followers to prepare for dreadful hardships after His death. John 12:20-50; Luke 21:5-36

Memory Verse: So also, when you see these things taking place, you know that the kingdom of God is near. Luke 21:31

May 27

Bible Truth: Jesus welcomes and rewards those who faithfully serve Him. Matthew 25

Memory Verse: *And the King will answer them, "Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me."* Matthew 25:40

June 3

Bible Truth: Jesus courageously faces the events that lead to His upcoming death. Matthew 26:1-35; John 13:1-20

Memory Verse: *Review the last four verses and say two of them to your KidsQuest teacher.*

June 10

Bible Truth: Jesus promises to help His disciples, even after He leaves. John 14:1-15:17

Memory Verse: *By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.* John 15:8

June 17
Father's Day

Bible Truth: Jesus prays that His followers will be "one" with God and each other. John 17

Memory Verse: *The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one.* John 17:22

June 24

Bible Truth: Jesus accepts the illegal arrest, trial, and mockery that lead to His death sentence. Matthew 26:36-27:26

Memory Verse: *And going a little farther He fell on His face and prayed, "My father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."* Matthew 26:39
