Team Details & Responsibilities

TIMELINESS

It is important to always be on time, and ready to go. If rehearsal starts at 7:30, make sure you arrive early enough to set up your instrument and plug in before 7:30. If we all respect each other's time, practice will flow more smoothly!

CALL TIMES:

- Wednesday Mid-Week Rehearsal – 7:30-9:00 for instrumentalists; 7:00-9:00 for vocalists. *(Summer times are adjusted)*
- Sunday Services – 7:30 AM—12:45PM *(This includes stage setup, sound check, rehearsal, Middle School service, Elementary School service, High School Service, and stage tear down).*
- Additional call times for special events and training as needed.

In addition to call times, you are expected to stay connected with the high school group. You are expected to be involved with your peers by setting a good example during announcements, games, activities, and the teaching. We want to lead the way for others in every part of the gathering.

PLANNING CENTER

All calendaring and scheduling will take place through *Planning Center*—an online tool that will become your best friend. On *Planning Center*, each week you will find:

- The audio files, lyrics, and chord charts you need
- The order of service
- Any special notes or arrangements
- The team you'll be serving with

Once you become part of the team, you will receive an email invitation asking you to login to your *Planning Center* account. This will be our primary mode of communication with you. We will help you learn to use it.

***There's also a *Planning Center App* that's very helpful.*

METHODS OF COMMUNICATION

You will be responsible to check your email/text messages to see any updates, additions, or changes. We will inform you of the songs you are responsible to learn and know, as well as any other information you'll need. If you are unclear about anything, please contact Nathan Abbott at any time.

DRESS CODE

Leading worship is an honor and also a big responsibility. Your example will be observed and followed by students in our ministry. We need to follow basic dress code guidelines in order to set a godly example. All worship team members are expected to dress above reproach: your attire should never cause someone to focus on what you're wearing instead of the Lord.
